



Format: A two-day medal competition comprising of:

A "Scratch" event – arguably the most prestigious competition in the Men's calendar - the winner of which becomes **CPGC Men's Club Champion**, and a handicap competition (**The Pednor Cup**).

For the handicap competition, any change to a player's Handicap Index arising after the Saturday round will NOT be applied to the Sunday round. A maximum Handicap Index of 30 applies - players with a HI over 30 are permitted to enter but their HI's will be capped at this level.

A player can only win one of these competitions (i.e. the winner of the Club Championships cannot also be the winner of the Pednor Cup).

Entry Fee: The entry fee is £5 and covers both competitions - please ensure you have sufficient funds on your levy card. Food is not included in the entry fee however the bar menu will be available as usual.

Entry Criteria: Only members with handicaps registered at Chartridge Park Golf Club (Home Club) may enter these two competitions. Players on 3-month 'introductory' memberships may play but are not eligible to win either competition.

Since the conclusion of the last Club Championships - Entrants must have played in:

- (a) A minimum of three Chartridge Park competitions* - one of which must have been in the 3 months preceding the date of the forthcoming Club Championships, OR
- (b) A minimum of two Chartridge Park competitions* AND submitted at least two General Play cards for WHS purposes (from any course) – one of the Competition rounds or one of the General Play rounds (18-holes) must have been in the 3-months preceding the date of the forthcoming Club Championships.

*Any singles competition that is not match-play and which counts towards your Handicap Index but excluding "Tuesday Nighters" and "POETS (or 9&Dine)".

Sign Up: Players registering are automatically entered for both competitions over both days. If after the first round, you decide not to play on the second day, you must notify a committee member or the General Manager **before leaving the club**. The entry fee will still be applied.

Tee Times: All players will start on the 1st hole. Exact tee times will be notified in advance. No entrants after 1200hrs on Saturday 08th June. **Important Note:** The lowest scoring 12 players in the "Scratch" event after Day 1 will play in the last 4 groups on Day 2 with the lowest gross scorers out last. Eligible players who are unable to play in the last 12 will be excluded from the Scratch competition. Players in contention for the Scratch event must make themselves available in the event of a play-off.

Additional Rules: Practice on the course between rounds is **NOT** permitted.

In the event of a tie at the conclusion of the 'Scratch' competition, the winner will be determined by a playoff. The handicap competition will be determined on countback.

Presentation of Prizes: The results of the competitions will be announced shortly after the final groups have completed the 2nd round (including any play-off holes if necessary). As is tradition, players not in the last groups are encouraged to gather around the 18th to watch the last groups finish and stay for the presentations.
